Our extensive grounds feature a spacious playing field, trim trail and a delightful wildlife area, all designed to support learning and provide a safe, enjoyable environment for our children. We also have an outdoor classroom that's perfect for lessons during warm weather and provides shelter during breaks.

We also offer a studio, music room and a kitchen for cookery lessons.

Intent of Our Curriculum

The curriculum at Orchard Community Primary School is designed to equip pupils with the knowledge, skills and cultural capital needed for lifelong success. We aim to nurture personal traits and qualities, fostering positive behaviour and attitudes for a strong foundation. Our curriculum focuses on high standards in English and Mathematics, while also providing a broad, inspiring and ambitious education across all subjects to develop well-rounded, confident and independent learners.

Personal Development and Inclusivity

We prioritise the holistic development of our pupils, integrating values-based education that addresses moral, spiritual, social and cultural growth alongside academic achievements. Our inclusive environment celebrates individuality, promotes respect and kindness and provides a rich array of creative, sporting and cultural opportunities. Through a varied curriculum and enrichment activities, we aim to build confident, lifelong learners who are prepared for future challenges and committed to their communities.

Positive Behaviour and Lifelong Learning

Orchard Community Primary School fosters positive behaviours and attitudes, teaching pupils to respect themselves and others, and to behave with integrity and safety. We support the emotional health of our pupils and staff, acknowledging that everyone faces challenges and may need support. Positive mental health is a collective responsibility; we promote it by fostering a sense of belonging, celebrating achievements and providing appropriate support.

We offer a safe, inclusive and inspiring environment where every community member feels valued. Believing in every child's right to a comprehensive education, we hold high expectations for all pupils, encouraging their full participation and achievement. Our commitment to equal opportunities is central to our ethos, setting suitable learning challenges and overcoming potential barriers.

Successful inclusion means every pupil feels a sense of belong, confident, happy, and is supported to make the best possible progress. Our dedicated SENDCO team ensures that pupils with special educational needs receive the necessary support to progress. We have a number of rooms that can be used for small group work, interventions or nurture sessions, including 'The Rainbow Room' and 'The Bubble Room'.

We are lucky to have two very experienced SENDCos – one full time SENDCO and a Deputy - who support pupils with SEND and additional needs to achieve their very best in their time at Orchard. This is achieved through extensive partnership working with their teachers, parents and wider services. We also have one member of staff who holds the 'Emotional Learning Support Assistant' qualification, who sees children for ELSA and counselling work during the academic day.

Anti-Bullying Ambassadors

Bullying is not tolerated. We prioritise creating a safe, inclusive environment where all learners can thrive. Our Year 2 and Year 6 Anti-Bullying Ambassadors are trained to maintain a safe school environment, lead assemblies promoting friendship and tolerance and support students during break and lunchtimes.

Inclusivity and high expectations for all

We pride ourselves on our inclusive nature and use our deep knowledge of each individual to motivate, encourage and care for them throughout their time at our school.

Enrichment

As part of our commitment to the personal development of our pupils, we offer a huge range of extra-curricular and enrichment activities both during school hours and after school.

Sport

Maintaining our Platinum School Games Mark underscores our dedication to fostering school sport and competition, with participation in various local sports events ranging from athletics to gymnastics. Plus our Sports Leaders from Years 3-6 actively promote healthy lifestyles, enriching our sports programs further.

Music

We offer 1:1 or small group peripatetic music lessons for drums, guitar, violin and piano as well as extracurricular clubs including drumming and choir. Small-scale musical performances take place in the community. Music Kids Academy provide whole-class music tuition in the recorder and lead assemblies/workshops.



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Our Wrap around Care

At Orchard we offer Breakfast and After School Club. We provide support for our families with a reliable option for childcare beyond school hours, offering peace of mind and flexibility.

Breakfast Club

7.45am - 8.45am Monday to Friday

Children take part in a variety of activities including sports, crafts and IT, preparing them for the school day.

After School Club

Operates from 3.15pm – 5.45pm Monday to Thursday, and until 4.15pm on a Friday.

It provides a perfect end to the busy school day and gives children an opportunity to let off steam or relax with friends.

After School Activity Clubs

There are also a number of other clubs held between 3.15pm - 4.15pm which the children can voluntarily join.
