The percentage of Y6 pupils meeting the expected standard as well as the Average Scaled Score has remained well above the National Average in all subjects again this year. This is a huge achievement.

EYFS - 71.8% of pupils achieved a Good Level of Development (GLD) in Reception Class. (The 2025/26 national average will be formerly published in October.)

Year 1 Phonics Screening - Pass Rate: 83.3%. (The 2025/26 national average will be published in October but the provisional average is 82% - our result is above this.)

Year 4 Multiplication Check - Average Score out of 25: 17.5. This is the lowest average since the check began, hence our whole school focus on securing better recall with multiplication facts next year.

These superb results are testimony to the high expectations set at Orchard, and all pupils should feel very proud of their accomplishments. This success also reflects the effort of the entire school. The staff's passion for teaching and support have been key to pupils' achievements. The work of the Teachers and Support Staff has created an environment where every child feels encouraged to succeed. Encouragement and support at home have played also a vital role in this success.
