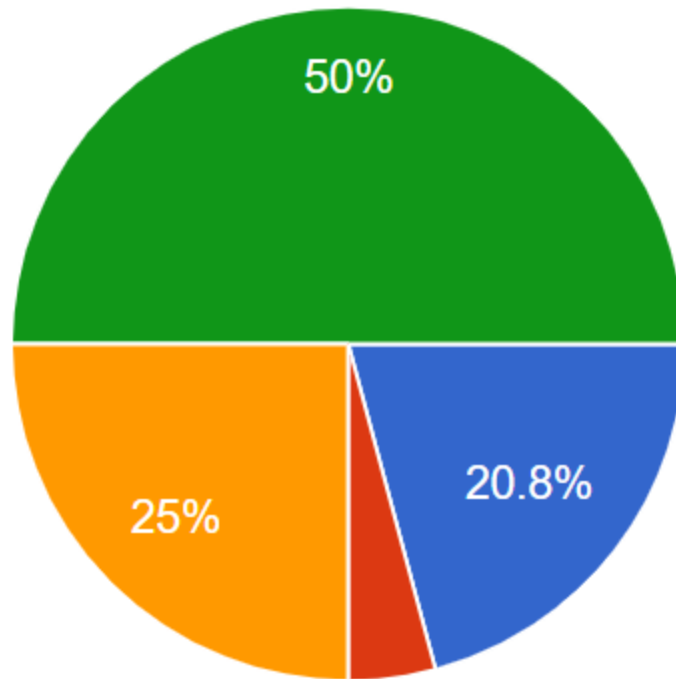

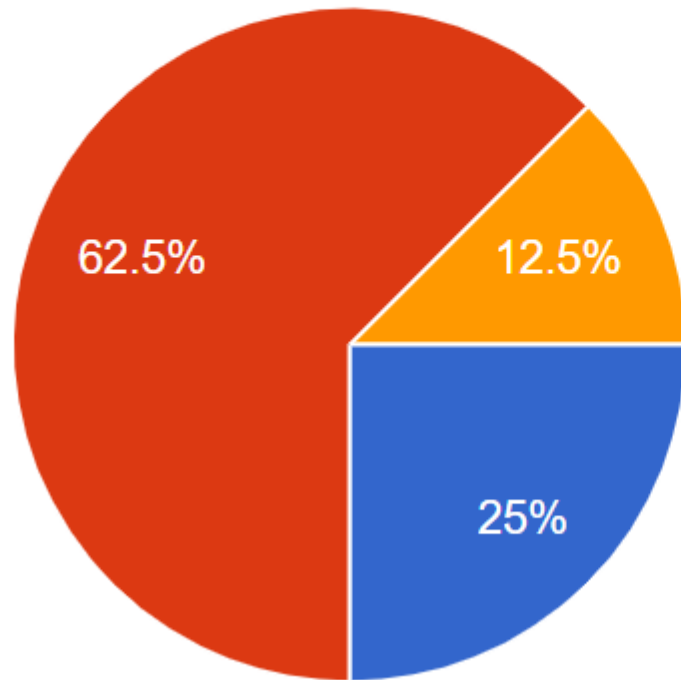

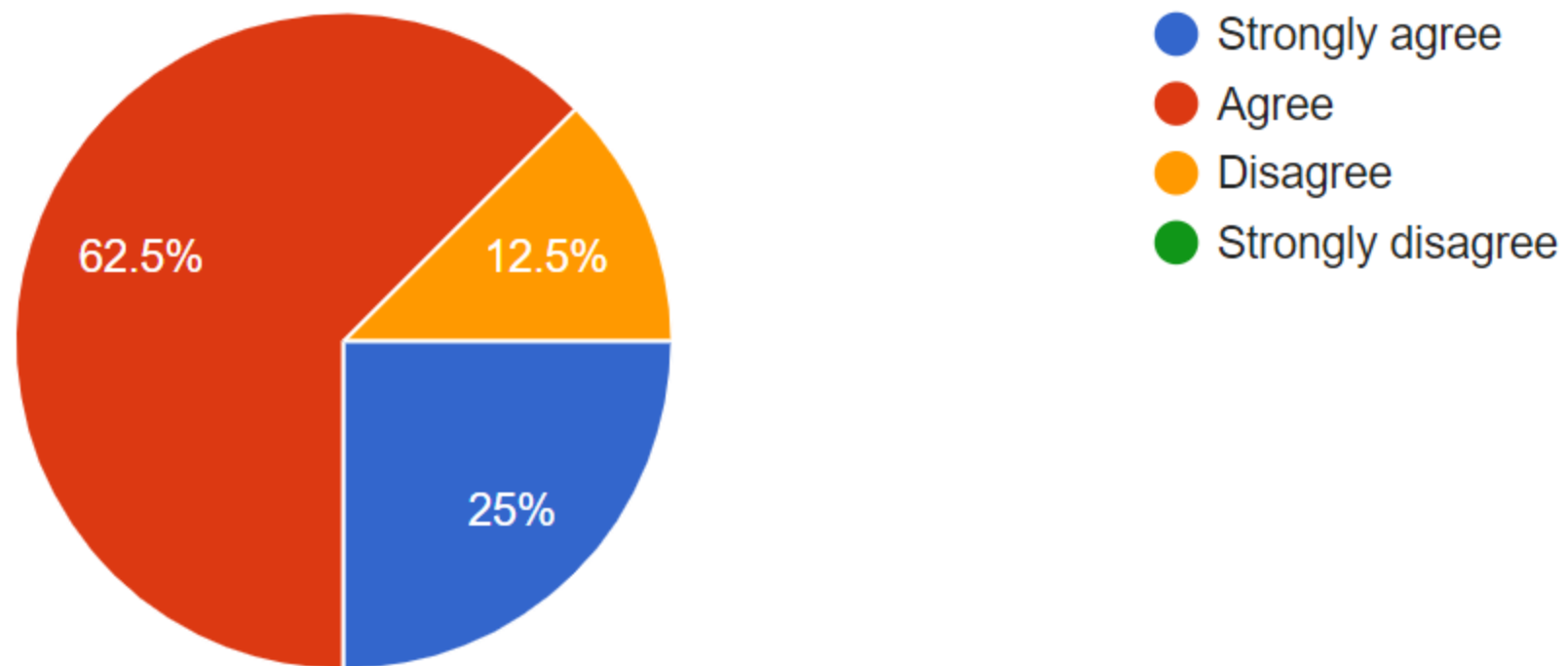

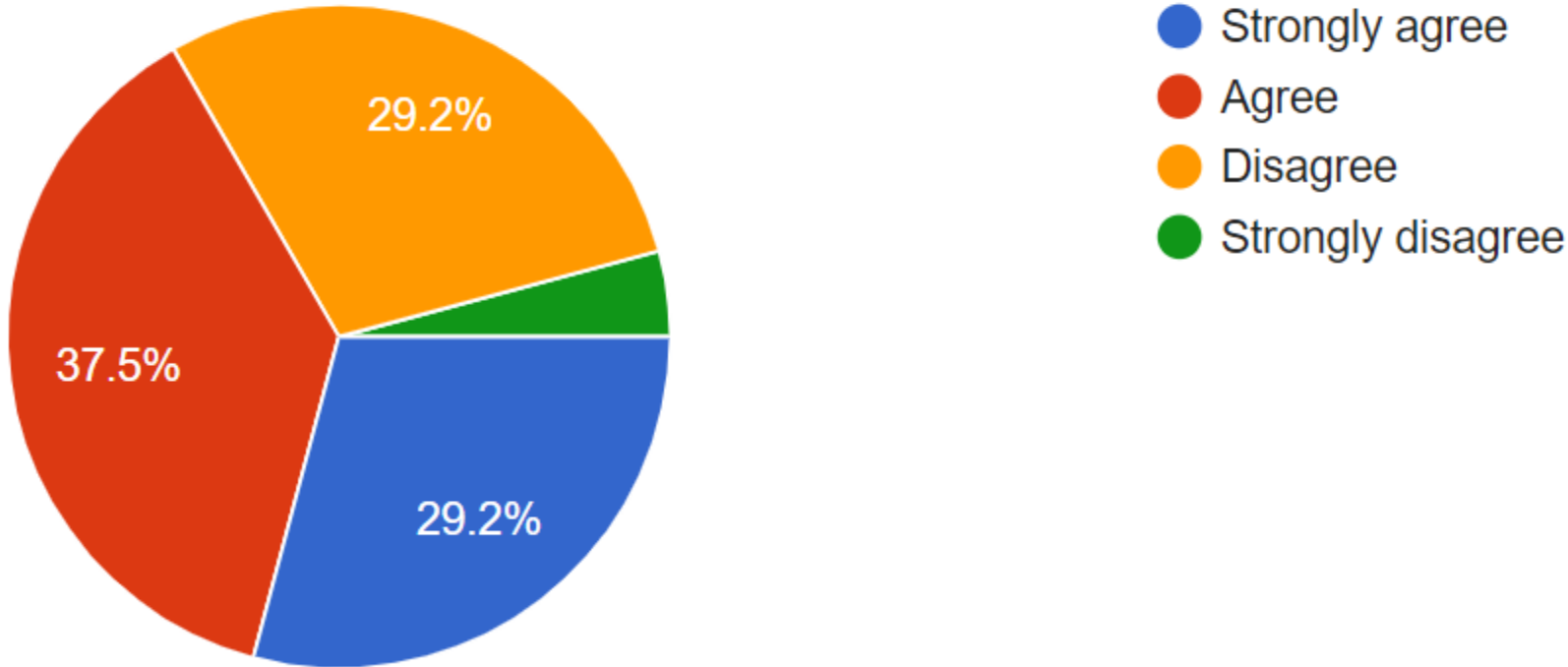
The activities set are interesting and there is a good variety of tasks

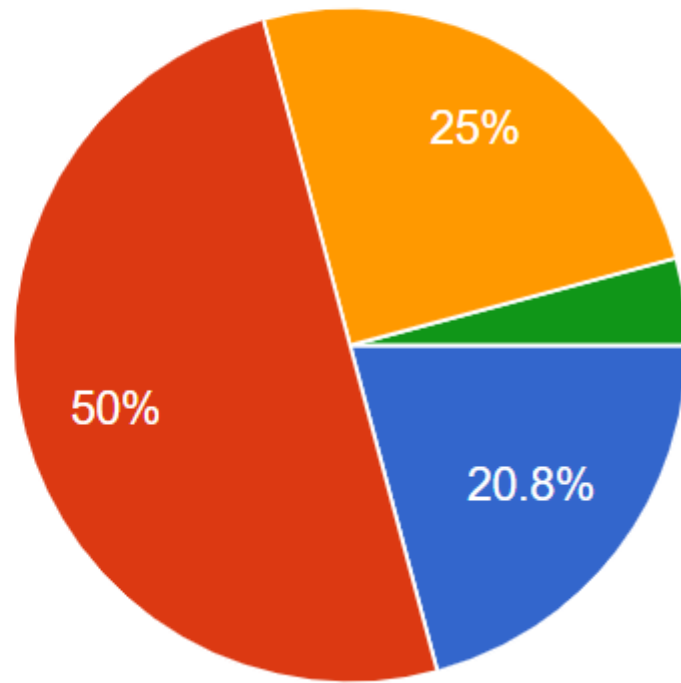
The amount of school work I have to complete is just right – not too much, not too little

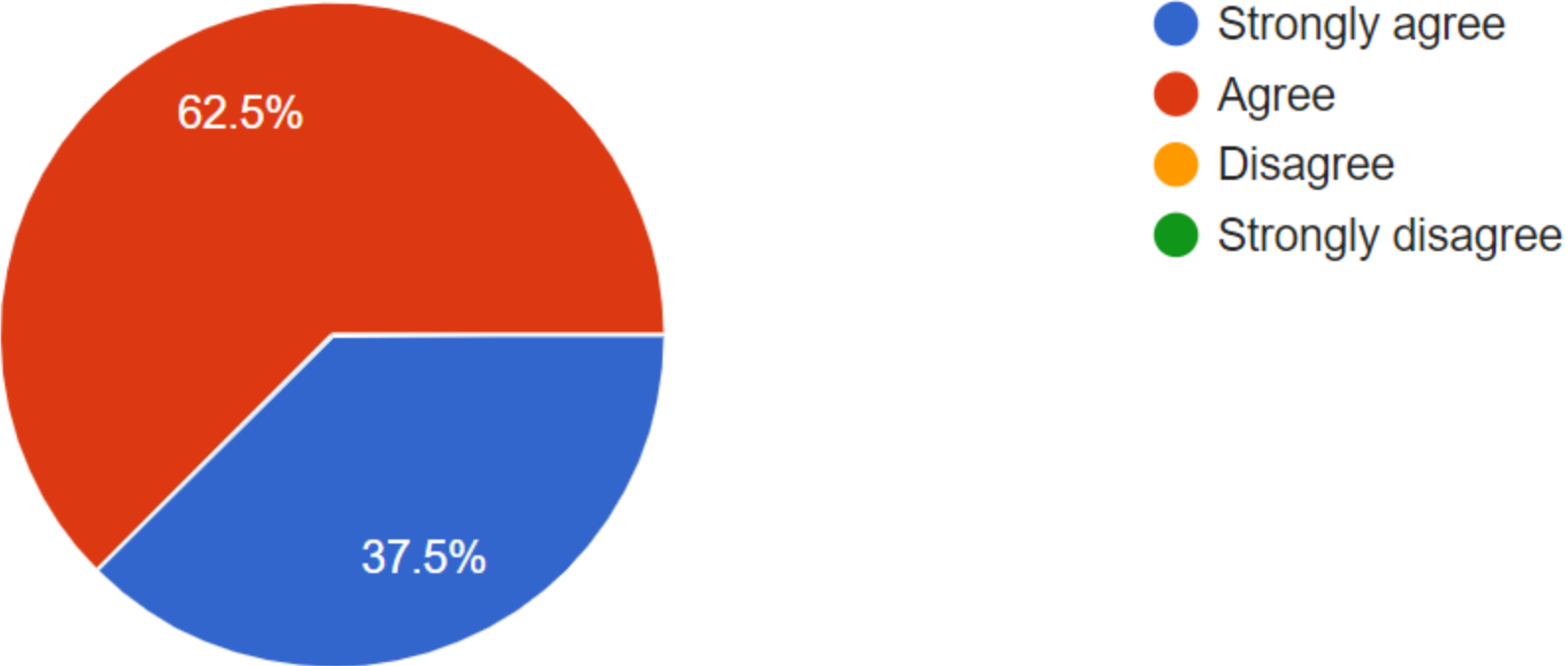

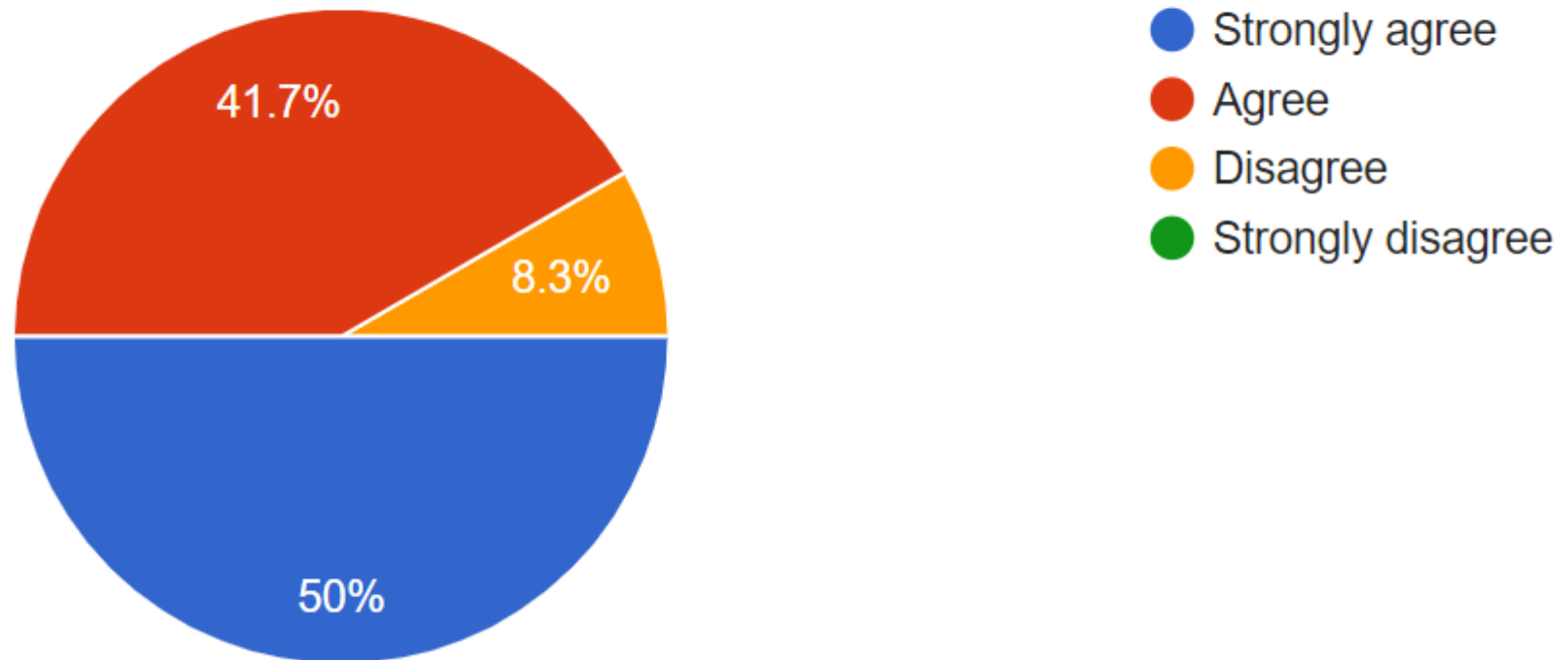
I know how to complete the school work my teachers are setting me in Maths

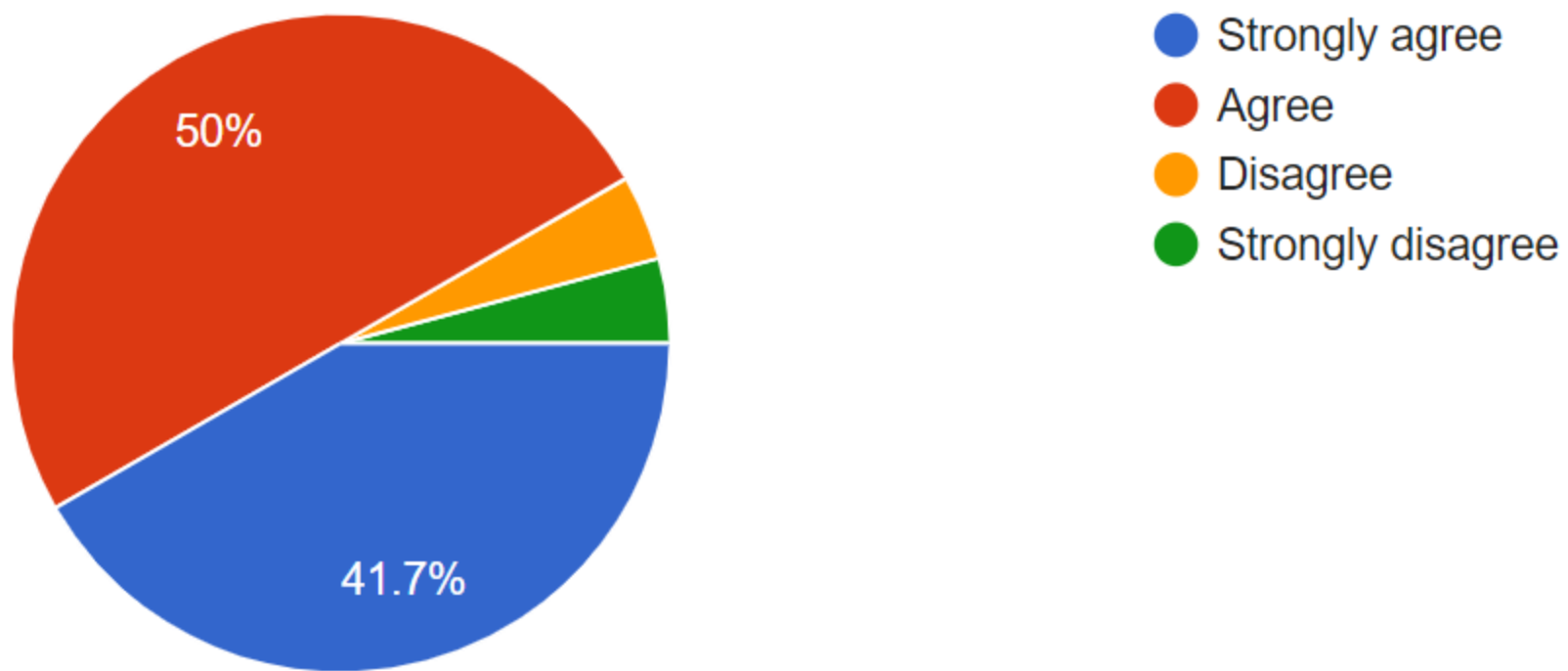
I know how to complete the school work my teachers are setting me in Writing

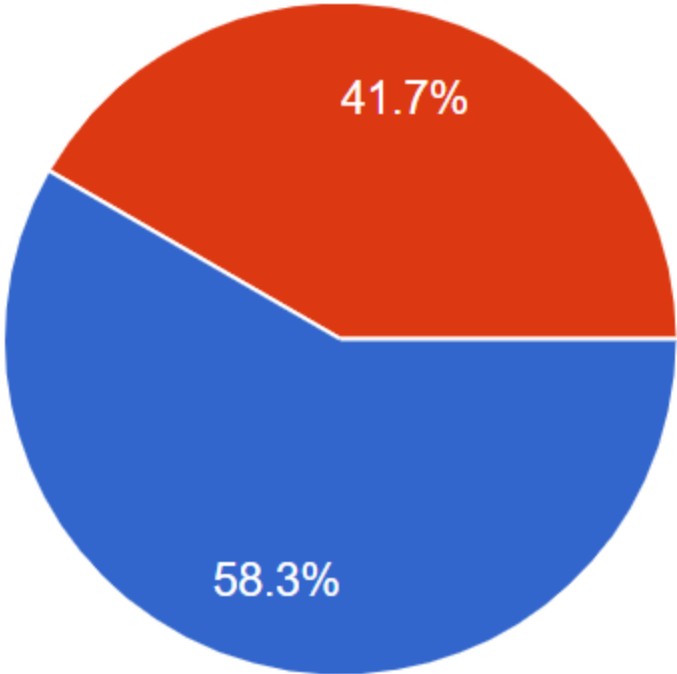
I know how to complete the school work my teachers are setting me in Shared Reading

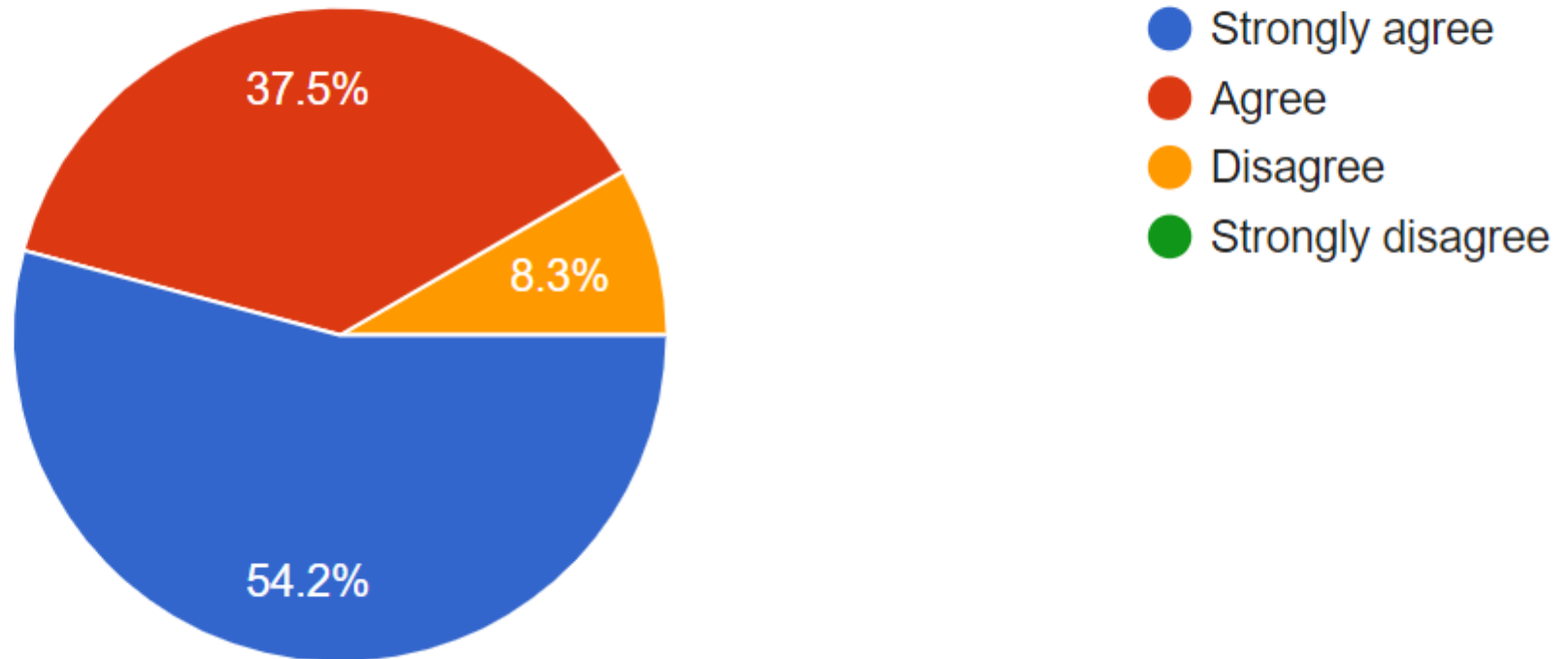

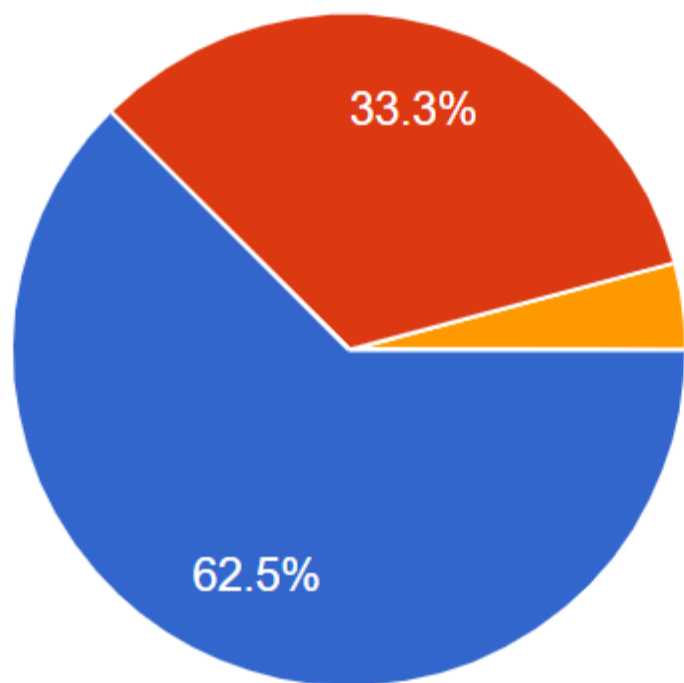

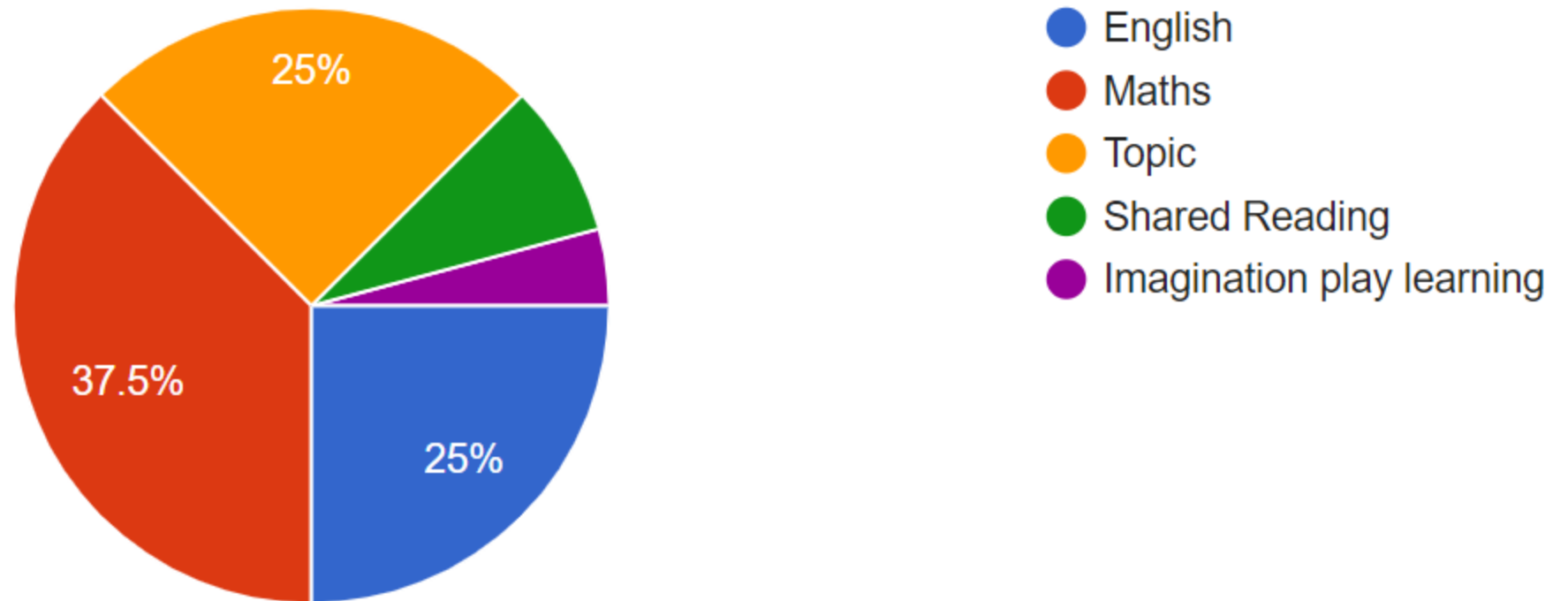

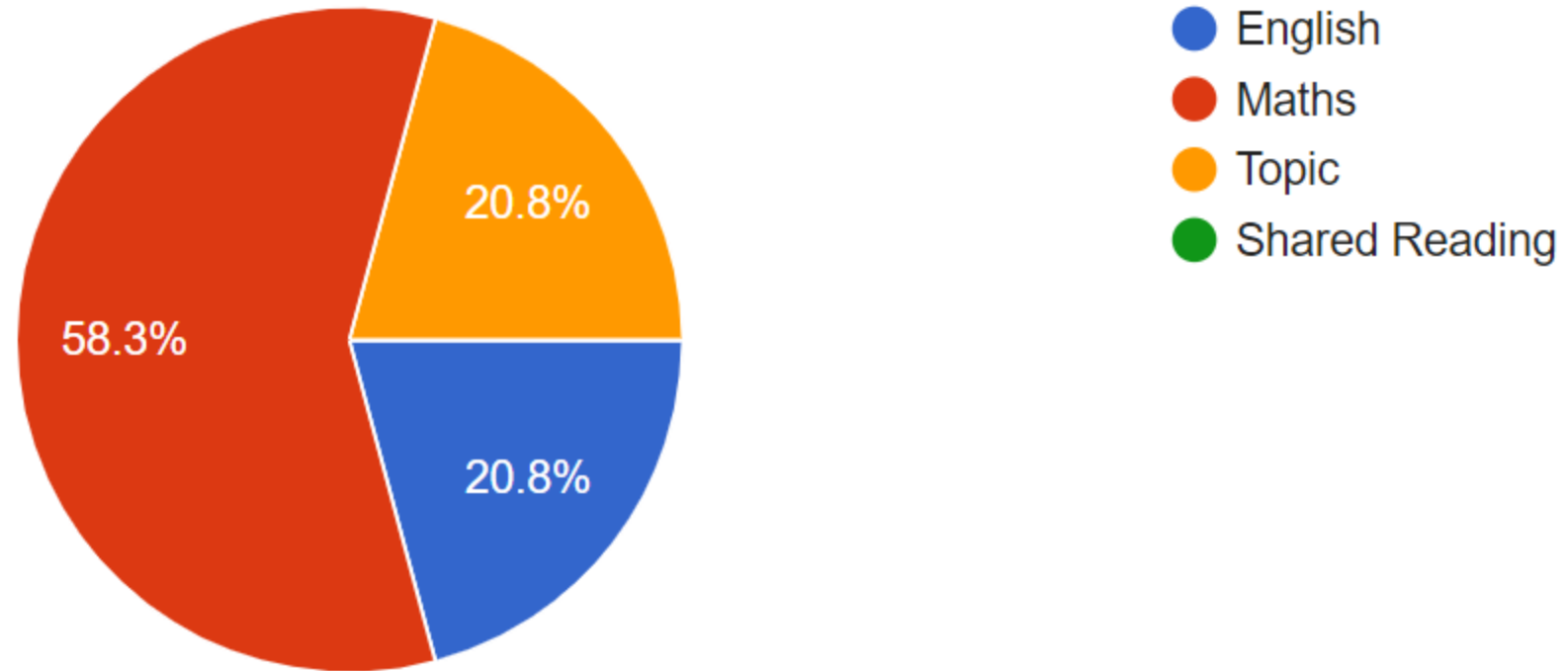

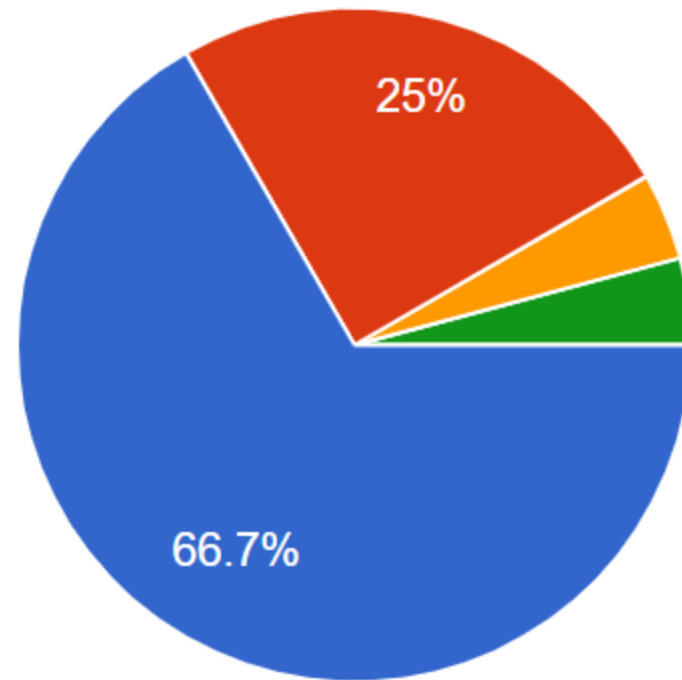

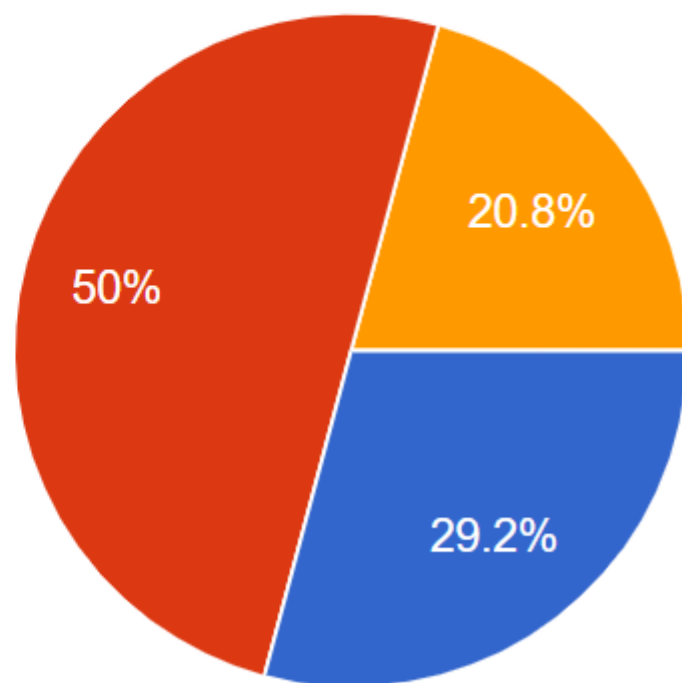
