



IS YOUR CHILD ENTITLED TO FREE SCHOOL MEALS?

If you receive any of the following benefits, your child/children may be entitled to free school meals.

- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment & Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)



APPLY NOW!

If you are entitled, school will receive additional funding which not only provides a school meal each day, but can also help with lots of other things including school trips, clubs, resources or any support or interventions your child needs in the classroom. If you do not apply and are entitled, we cannot receive extra funding for such things.
