Geography

The children will be:

Making maps.

Understanding mapping symbols

Grid referencing.

Understanding a place through physical and human geography

Comparing location for similarities and differences.

Undertake field work to find out information about Matlock Bath and Castle Donington.

Inspiration Day:

Mantle of The Expert – A letter from Derbyshire County Council to help produce a persuasive brochure promoting Matlock Bath.

Learn about maps and map skills including: Grid referencing, OS map symbols and keys, contour lines and land use of local areas near to Matlock Bath and Castle Donington.

We will plan a route and create a table top map of Castle Donington which includes the main features and important places that the children feel should be added.

Maths

The children will:

Create a survey based on a location.

Collect data

Learn how to make graphs and pictograms

Use pictograms and graphs to display data

Interpret data and make conclusions.

Art

The children will learn about the techniques of creating and painting landscapes.

They will learn about a famous landscape artist David Hockney and create their own version of his famous painting Garrowby Hill.

Computing

Year 3 – Will be exploring the links between events and actions. Learners will design and code their own maze-tracing program.

Year 4 – Will be exploring loops used in coding and create their own loop games.

Children will also use word and excel to form graphs and results

RSE:

Year 3 – Recognising that change is a part of growing up and be able to identify different types of relationships. They will reflect on the need for love and trust in relationships and what makes a positive relationship. They will also be revising the correct names for the body parts and organs in the body.

Year 4 – describing how to cope with change and understand the need for hygiene during puberty. Consider why people get married and to understand positive qualities in themselves. Develop an awareness of pressure to conform to gender and strategies on how to deal with gender-based prejudice.

French

Consolidation of key French learning this year including numbers, days of the week, months of the year and simple conversation French learned in previous terms.
